

If you use groundwater for any non-domestic purpose, the BC Government requires that you obtain a water licence. This requirement came into force on 29 February 2016 with the *Water Sustainability Act*. By obtaining a water licence, you will have a legal right to use groundwater and enjoy greater security of access to the water for your operation. Let us help you through the licence application process – join our workshop on 16 August 2017 at the Okanagan College Penticton Campus, presented with two sessions starting at 1:30pm and again at 6:00pm.

- You're a member of the BCGA or an agriculturalist in the South Okanagan/Similkameen
- You use ground water for agriculture


- Background information and opportunity for questions & answers from government staff on how the BC water rights system affects you
